Rule 5103. Custody of Exhibits. Special Provisions.

(a) Any non-documentary exhibit which is retained by the Proponent during or after the Court, Master, or Hearing Officer proceeding must be photographed in color by the Proponent and presented in a letter-sized form $(8 \ 1/2 \ x \ 11 \ inches)$ document for inclusion in the record prior to the end of the proceeding. The photograph shall be marked as an exhibit and identified in the exhibits index.

(b) Any digital exhibit that is not also presented via photograph, and any documentary exhibits of extraordinary size or bulk shall be entered into the record on a Universal Serial Bus (USB) flash drive. Multiple digital exhibits may be submitted by a party on one USB flash drive.
