

## **RULE 9.6 NOTICE OF FILING REPORT. FORM OF NOTICE. OBJECTIONS.**

(a) An Auditor or Hearing Officer appointed by the Court pursuant to 20 Pa. C.S. §751 shall give notice by First Class mail of the filing of any report to counsel, unrepresented parties or other interested parties of record. Proof of service shall be attached to the report. Said notice shall state that any party of record may file objections thereto within twenty (20) days from the filing of any such report.

If objections are filed, the matter will be set for argument at a date & time set by Court Administration and a briefing schedule will issue forthwith.

(b) The notice required above shall be in the following form:

**TAKE NOTICE**, that the undersigned, the duly appointed **auditor**, (hearing officer) **filed** his (her) Report with the Clerk of the **Orphans'** Court Division on \_\_\_\_\_, 2\_\_\_\_. A copy of the **Report** is attached.

Under the Local **Orphans'** Court Rules, you have twenty (20) days from the date the **Report** was **filed** to **file** written objections to it with the Clerk of the **Orphans'** Court Division. If you fail to do so, the Court may confirm the **Report** (may adopt the recommendations of the **Report**).
